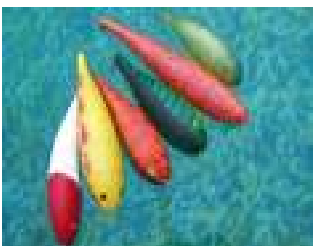
Wood Burning Techniques
