- Do demonstrations, especially in the afternoons and weekends
- Help set up the booth on Sunday August 5, from 9am to whenever we get done (usually about 1pm)
- Help tear down the booth Sunday night August 19 at about 9pm
- And finally a couple of people who can be available Monday August 20
  in the morning to help take the last of the material out (we can not take
  trucks into the fair Sunday night)

And most importantly, exhibitors are needed, see the fair show book. The exhibits can be brought in Sunday during the setup, or on Monday or Tuesday during the day. There is a \$50 prize for best of show.

This is a good way to meet other gourd people in a relaxed setting. <u>Get your patch together and come to the fair as a group!</u>
