QUICK TIPS an archived *Jim Story article*

Need thick plexiglas for making molds in which to grow gourds? A great source is Menards Building Stores.

Cement reinforcing wire (trade name Remesh) and cattle panels make the very best gourd trellises, arbors & fences. Remesh comes in rolls 150 feet long and 5 feet wide. Cattle panels and Remesh can be purchases at most building supply stores. Look for bargains in cattle panels at farm sales. Remesh makes excellent tomato cages and flower towers. Bolt cutters are needed to cut Remesh when making gourd trellises and tomato cages.

Gourd stems have skins. Cleaning the stems of gourds improves their appearance. The secret to easy stem cleaning is to first scrape with a knife, then soak in warm water for 30 minutes, scrape again with a knife and then use a one inch stainless steel brush to remove remaining skin particles.

An electric fan will hasten the drying of gourds. Just lay them in front of an electric fan turned on high and the drying process starts immediately.
