(Late Entry Processing Charge - additional \$25.00)

*Entries without correct fees included will be returned.

*A department/section/class number must be listed on the lines below for EACH item entered.

*One entrant per form - entry Form may be photocopied.

*The Indiana State Fair, Indiana State Fair Board, Indiana State Fair Commission, and all employees associated with each organization assume no liability of claims for the safety of exhibits while on the Fairgrounds. All applications are tendered and accepted upon that condition.

*Each entrant will receive 6-one day passes to the Fair.

*Use separate entry form for each department.

***No additions may be made.**

***Entry fees are non-refundable.**

***Incomplete entries will be returned and subject to applicable late fees.**

*Each Exhibitor must pay all fees at time of making entry.
