On April 1 dot painting will be concluding and Easter bunny necklaces will be on the agenda, while on April 15 the group will begin wood burning and painting flowers on gourds. 

### **Indiana Gourd Society Administration**

The board of directors has voted to provide more transparency to the operations of the society by asking a representative (generally the patch leader) of each patch to sit on an advisory board along with the officers. Each patch should send their patch leader or designee to board meetings. These representatives will have full voting rights on matters brought before the board. Reasoning: some patch members have expressed concern that they don't know how the society operates or why certain decisions are made. By having representation, each patch can get first-hand information about the society and have a louder voice in the operations of the society. If a patch leader cannot go to a meeting, they may (before the board meeting) contact the secretary with the name of their representative.



### **Future Gourd Show Themes**

The show committee is seeking possible themes for future state gourd shows. The goal is to have themes identified two to three years ahead of the show. The theme applies only to a limited number of competition classes. That will give us time to publicize the event and make posters for distribution at the state fair and other events throughout the year. # HOW TO ENTER OPEN CLASSES AT THE INDIANA STATE FAIR 2020

The IGS State Show is not the only place to show your gourds. The STATE FAIR has a gourd competition each year! Everyone is eligible. You don't have to have won anything at your county fair or anywhere else. There aren't as many classes and they differ from the IGS State Show.

Last year, \$40 let you enter any open class in the Ag-Hort building. There are a few hundred opportunities because you aren't confined to gourds. You get 6 complimentary tickets. Fair ticket prices range from \$8 pre-fair to \$13 at the gate. That's worth \$48-\$78. In addition, 1st, 2nd, & 3rd places in all competitions get monetary awards.
