Our show plans for the 2023 State Gourd Show are MOVING right along and we are "On the Road Again" —the location, date, time, length of the show for 2023. A one day show on Saturday, April 8, 2023 will be held at Hendricks County 4-H Fairgrounds and Conference Center, 1900 E. Main St. in Danville, Indiana 46122. The theme for the IGS 2023 Gourd Show is "**On the Road Again**."

The 2023 Competition Show Book and Information Book are now on-line. Some important changes were made to the Competition Book, so look at it carefully. We have fewer Competition Categories/classes this year. Also the competition levels went from four (N, I, A, M) to two (A - Amateur, P - Professional).

- <u>Amateur</u>: Is at beginning/intermediate skill level of a technique or category. Does not sell any art/craft work or teach classes for money.
- <u>Professional</u>: Is **beyond** intermediate skill level of a technique or category. May sell art/craft work or teach classes for money.
- <u>All Entrants:</u> May NOT regress if entering a new technique or category. That is, if you are a professional in one technique, you must enter any other technique as a professional.

The Workshop Flyer will be on line in February, 2023. IGS is looking for workshop teachers/ classes for the 2023 show. If you are interested, see the Teachers Application 2023 in this *Tendril*, or on the IGS Website. The 2023 Vendors Form is also in this *Tendril* and on the website. So come join us!
